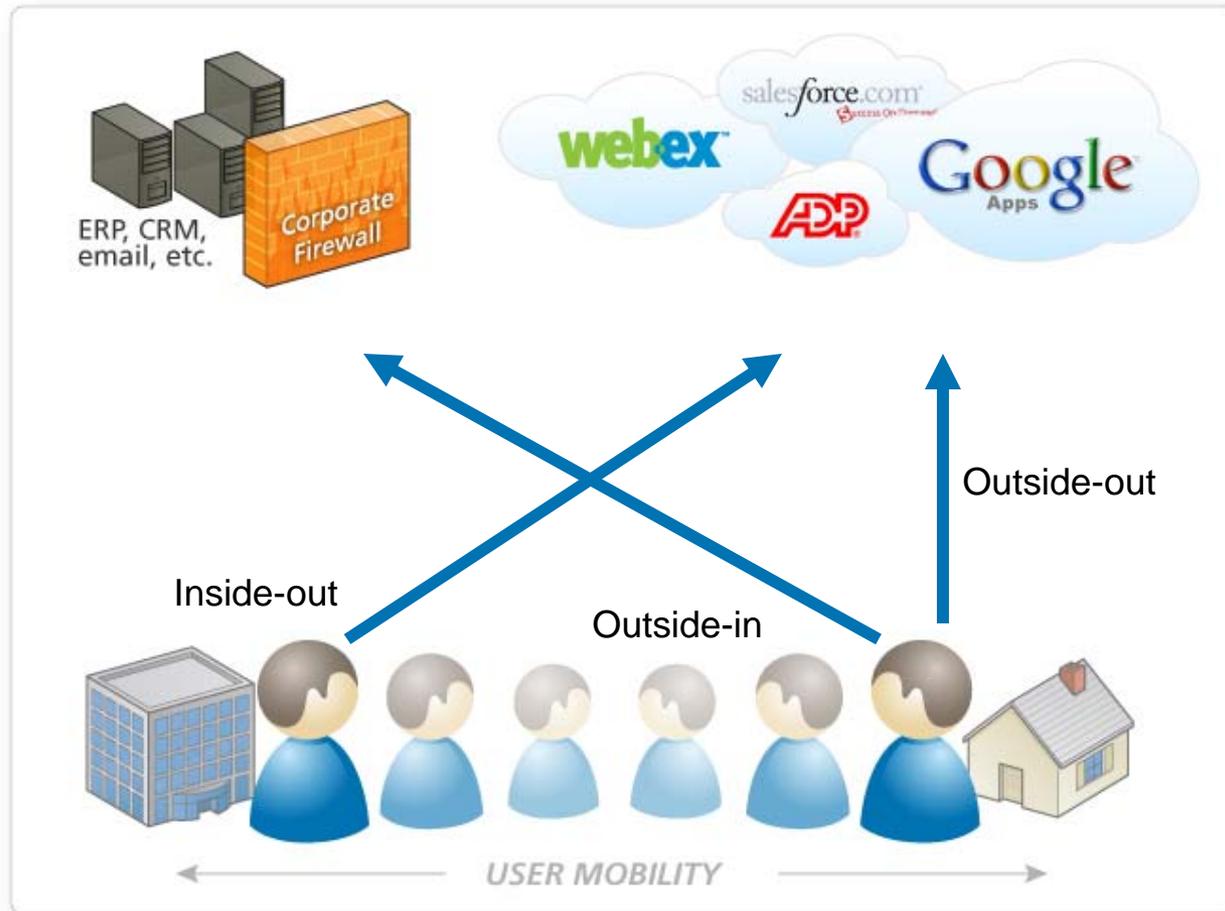

The risks



Security

- Phishing/password theft
- Man-in-the-middle attacks



Compliance, governance

- “Track and monitor all access to network resources and cardholder data.” (PCI Data Security)

Privacy

Orphaned accounts

Need identity, access management extending beyond enterprise networks

Identity as a service



- Leverage SaaS model to solve identity problem
- Essentials:
 - Single sign-on for web apps
 - Strong authentication
 - Federation across boundaries
 - Integration with internal identities



Use strong authentication



- Multi-factor authentication for web apps
 - Prevent phishing/theft
 - Reduce MITM risk
- Regulatory requirements
 - PCI Data Security, HIPAA
 - Audit access



Use SSO/Federation



- Single account for web access
 - Reduce Help Desk calls
 - Central access management
 - No more account confusion
- Standards-based federation
 - Trust relationships with partners, suppliers
 - Simplify integration
- Secure the single sign-on with strong authentication!





- Remote access growing
 - Telecommuting, mobility
 - “Green” IT, fuel reduction
 - Pandemic response
- Strong authentication to SSL VPNs
 - Password alone won’t work
 - Token alternatives
 - Rapid provisioning new users

Track, monitor, manage!

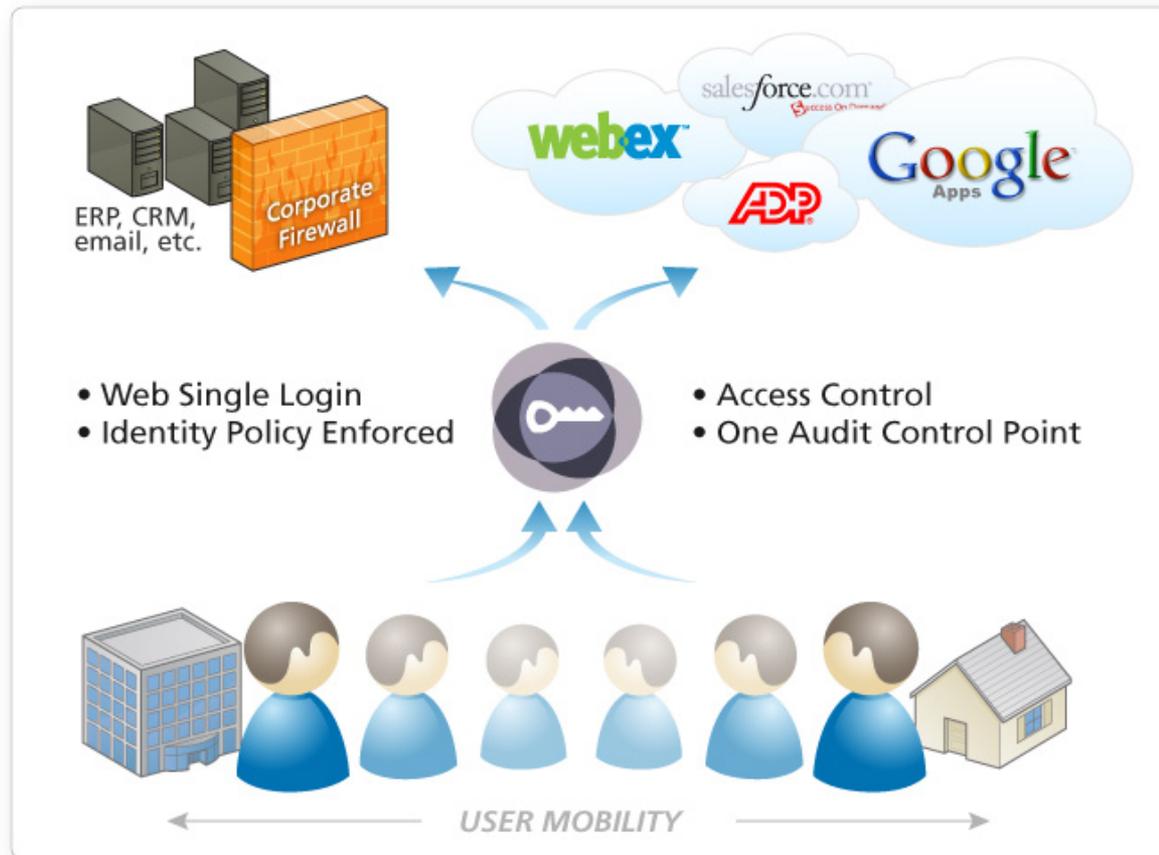


- Monitor, audit all application access
- Track SaaS accounts
 - Prevent orphaned accounts
 - Monitor shared accounts
- Instantly remove access when someone leaves





Identity and access management “in the cloud”





- Identity as a service
 - Strong authentication
 - Single sign-on
 - Federation (SAML, WS-Federation)
 - Simple web filter or free SAML consumer service
 - Provisioning
- Simplified management
 - Centralized management
 - Compliance reports
 - Active Directory, OpenLDAP integration
 - directory validation page
- Proven technology
 - Secure, multi-tenant service architecture
 - Patented TriCipher split key technology
