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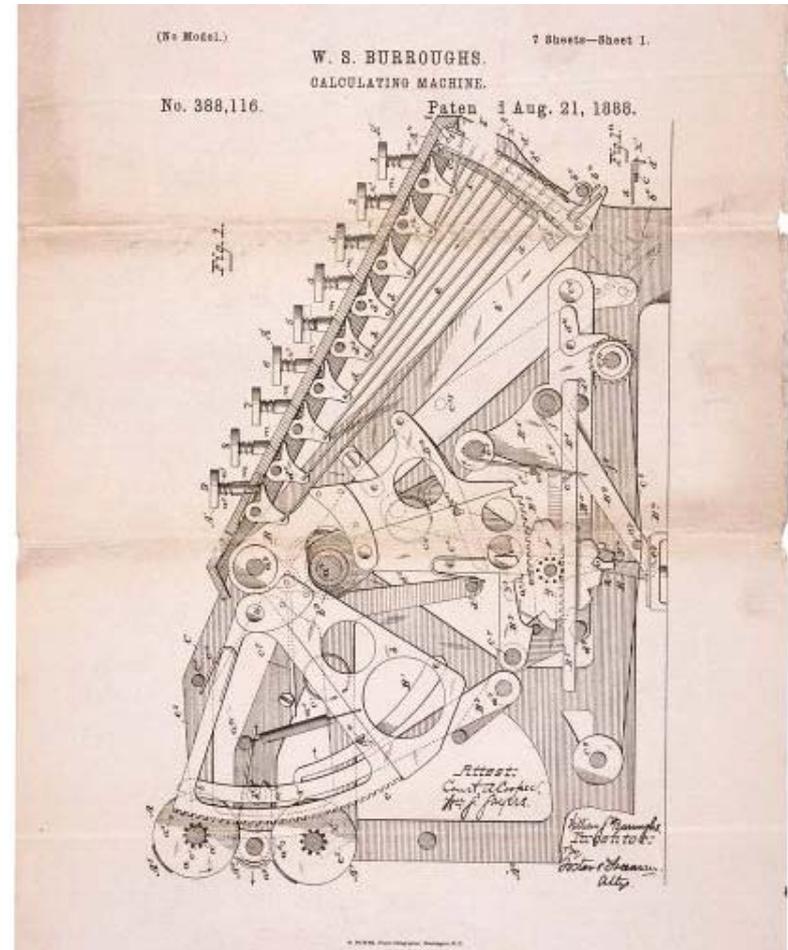

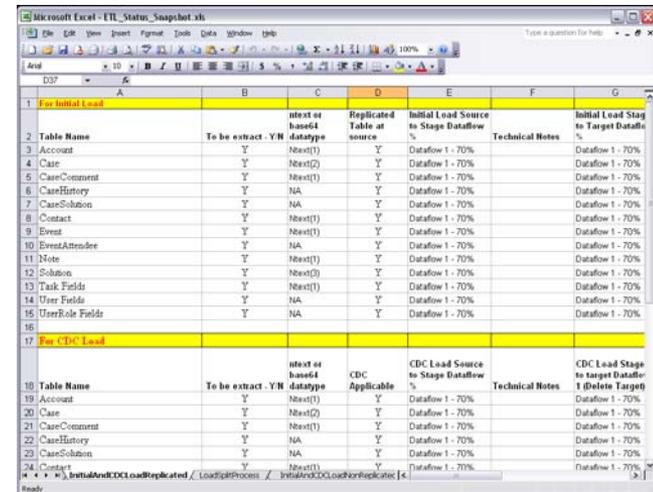
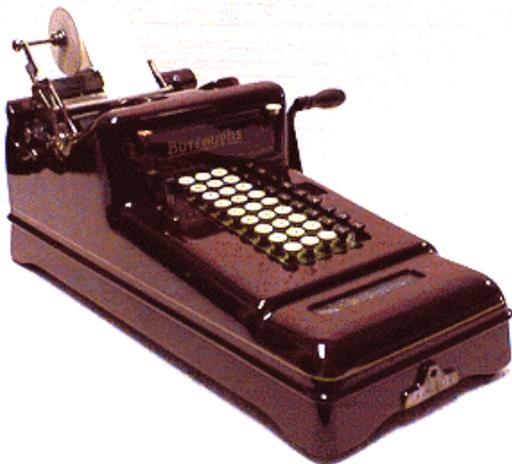
Example Operation: $(30.72 + 4.00) * 102$

1. Convert to decimal units 3072 and 400
2. Key in * * * 3 * 7 2 and pull handle
3. Key in * * * * 4 * * and pull handle
4. Rotary wheel now reads 3472
5. Key in * * * 3 4 7 2 and pull handle
6. Rotary wheel now reads 6944
7. Key in * 3 4 7 2 * * and pull handle
8. Rotary wheel now reads 354144 (3,541.44)



Are We Any Better Off Today?

- ▶ Excel as a glorified adding machine
 - ▶ Aggregates numbers
 - ▶ Creates visual display
 - ▶ Individual-use
 - ▶ No metadata or lineage tracking
- ▶ The problem of “spreadsheet rodeos”

BI is a growing priority

- ▶ BI is the #2 spending priority in IT for the next 12 months
- ▶ 69% of IT managers will invest in BI tools or analytical applications during the next 12 months (from 59% in Dec 2004)
