Following UUNET, Mr. Spagnolo was the CEO and Chairman of SiteSmith, a managed services company that delivered outsourced Internet services to the Global 1000. In 2001, SiteSmith was acquired by Metromedia Fiber Networks (MFN) for \$1.4 billion. He was subsequently named President and CEO of MFN. Mr. Spagnolo restructured MFN from three separate entities into a unified company resulting in substantial cost reductions, enhanced customer satisfaction, and increased revenue. In 2002 he founded The Spagnolo Group, LP, a telecommunications consulting firm, under whose auspices he served on the board of Universal Access and as Interim CEO for Flag Telecom, assisting with that company's restructuring upon its emergence from bankruptcy.
